juridical issues – solving marriage cases; solving problems of heritages, public deposits, owns, loans, bankruptcies, rents, auctions, felonies; reaching verdicts, serving penalties;

economy – industrial production (implementation of silk manufacturing in Zemun, foundation of fabric of tobacco and potash, performance of: the fabric manufacturing arms in Ferlak, fabrics for processing fur in Serbia and fabric manufacturing leather in Canton of Slunj;

mining – miners in Oravica, Moldava, Bokšan;

forestry – forests protection and deforestation;

agriculture – cultivation, vegetables, flax, hemp, cotton, mulberry, vineyard, orchard; cattle; hunt and fishing;

trade – products export to Serbia: meal, corn, sustaining food , fish, textile, bar; products import from Serbia: wax, wool, leather, tallow, honey, cattle, wood;

workcraft – guilds performing in Zemun: carpenters, moulder, guns manufacturers, watch makers, soap producers, kebab makers;

performance of monetary bureaus - money, budgets, accounts, bills, obligation lists;

traffic – transport of people and goods;

construction and community issues – constructing and renovating buildings, streets and parks, schools, gates, poles; construction material, workers; city lightening and lanterns; construction of break waters, bridges, wells; streets cleaning service; water supplying, cemetery observance;

education – performance of schools and teachers (working programs, books, educational assets, school buildings, budget);

culture – theater troops and shows; organizing dances and parties; musicians and instruments; making private libraries and lists of Serbian books; performance of bookstores and printing houses; publishing leaves and magazines, calendars, revolutionary activities of leaf "Zastava" and „Srpsko kolo", humoristic leaf „Vrzino kolo", leaf „Radnik", „Dar-mar", communist leaf „Sloboda", than leaf „Borba" and „Srpska nezavisnost";

church and priests;

healthcare – performance of hospitals, doctors, midwives and sergeants; the most common diseases (smallpox, venereal illness, fever, deuce, eyes illness, dysentery); curing (hospital, spa); cattle illnesses; providing quarantine, issuing and implementing medical regulation, medical mistakes; pharmacies and pharmacists performing, medicines supplying, public bath work;

social care – taking care of orphans, cripples, deaf, blind, mentally disturbed;

natural disasters – prevent and removal of flooding effects, disasters made by wind, fire, and invasion of grasshoppers;

ethnography – population (Jews settlement from Belgrade to Zemun in 1862, Serb families movement to Belgrade and Serbia in 1881, issuing permits for: colonization of Zemun land or

emigration and getting citizenship; keeping evidence of: Zemun population, Jews and Turks staying in Zemun; Armenians, Gypsies and Cincars
